Entries and Limitations:

Swimmers will swim all 5 (individual) events for the pentathlon

Coaches are to use their judgement when entering distance events.

Swimmers with provincial qualifying times (A or AA) will be dequalified from the pentathlon races but may enter the distance.

All Entries must include an entry time. NT's will not be accepted as per SNM rules.

Meet management reserves the right to adjust warm up time, limit the number of entries for the distance to ensure length of session is kept short and will notify clubs of changes.

That includes 2.50 SNM Program Development Fee per event and 7.00 Swim Canada Participation fee per swimmer.

All entry fees must be received by the first day of the meet.

Deck Entries:

Additional swims may be permitted if lane space is available, but no additional heats will be created. Must provide Swimmers SNC ID Number and birthdate. Swimmer/Coach must present the late entry fee of 30 minutes prior to the beginning of the session.

The cost for each deck entry is \$20.00.

Payment in cash or cheque payable to Brandon Bluefins must accompany the entry when handed to the Administration Desk

Starts will be conducted from Starting Platforms (blocks) as per FINA FR 2.3 and SW4.1 or deck surface.

Structure and Format: Age of a swimmer is determined by their age as of Feb 28th 2025

Session 1-3:

The competition is Timed Finals and will include the following age groups:

Girls: 10 & Under, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & Over Boys: 10 & Under, 11-13, 14-15, 16 & Over

Seeding:

Entries will be seeded open (all ages) mixed gender, slowest to fastest Coaches are requested to submit entry times for each entry.

Awards:

Heat Winner, Bell prizes
High point award for each age group for the pentathlon.
800 Free is not included in the high point pentathlon award

<u>Scoring:</u> for high point will be: First place 5 points, Second place 3 points and third place 1 point
