Entries and Limitations:

Swimmers are restricted to 3 events per session, plus the 50 drill except for Friday.

Coaches will enter swimmers in events that is compatible with the swimmer's ability.

All Entries must include and entry time. NT's will not be accepted as per SNM rules.

Free Relays and Medley relays

Will be chosen by appointed coaches (like provincial relays) Each coach will have caps for their teams (pig, cow, and duck)

Will be a mix of all ages and clubs.

Each relay will be comprised of a swimmer from each age group.

Coaches will receive a list of swimmers to pick from If the swimmers are picked for the free relay, they should not participate in the Medley relay, giving all swimmers a chance to race (entries permitting, may need to overlap) There will be 2 teams from each group making 6 relays (entries permitting)

Entry Fees

Flat fee of \$110.00 which includes program fee and all SNC fees

All entry fees must be received by the first day of the meet.

Online Entries

Entries must be compiled electronically via the online system The entry system can be accessed via www.swimming.ca (Swim Canada)

Entries will ONLY be accepted through Swim Canada website. Entries must include the following:

Valid Swimmer ID

Correct birthdate

Para swimmers must have their classification after their name in the entries.

Refunds:

Meet Management is not obligated to refund entry fees after the entry deadline date.

Deck Entries:

Additional swims may be permitted if lane space is available, but no additional heats will be created. Note: swimmers cannot exceed the maximum number of swims indicated per session in entries and limitations. Swimmers not entered in meet will pay the full fee and must provided birthdate and SNC number for entry

Swimmer/Coach must present the late entry fee of 30 minutes prior to the beginning of the session.

The cost for each deck entry is \$20.00.

Payment in cash or cheque payable to Brandon Bluefins must accompany the entry when handed to the clerk of course. These swims will be exhibition only.

Scratches:

Structure and Format:

The competition will include the following age groups:

Girls: 10 & Under, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & Over

Boys: 10 & Under, 11-13, 14-15, 16 & Over

Age of a swimmer is determined by their age as of Nov 29 2024

The competition will be timed finals for all events.

Seeding:

Entries will be seeded open (all ages) by gender, slowest to fastest Coaches are requested to submit entry times for each entry.
